Send a Migrant Child to School Program

Genesis Diez, A.C. continues their campaign to send indigenous migrant children to school. The migrants are the poorest of the poor in Baja California Mexico and many of their children have never attended school because they cannot afford to buy the uniforms and supplies required.

Genesis Diez, A.C. has a seven-year history working with indigenous migrant families. We currently have relations with six migrant communities south of Ensenada. These people earn very little for their labor in the surrounding fields. The Genesis Diez, A.C. 2008 "Send a Migrant Niño to School" campaign was very successful and also brought to light the issue of birth certificates. Children who do not have birth certificates can not register to enter school. Those who do have birth certificates often don't go to school because of the cost of school supplies, uniform and shoes. Older children work in the fields or care for younger siblings while the rest of the family works. The application process for obtaining birth certificates for children and adults is a Genesis ongoing year-round endeavor. Because so many were never able to afford birth certificates, they are not able to obtain legal documentation for medical help or fight for rights when the farm owners decide to hold up wages for some unknown reason. These families live in single 12' x 12' concrete-block rooms or homes built out of garage doors and/or pallets - with no running water. Genesis also tries to help meet some of the basic needs of these families through the program *Food & Prayer*. This program distributes food baskets, blankets, and clothing to the families, builds relationships and offers Christian spiritual support and prayer.

With your help, we can provide school supplies, uniforms, and/or shoes to those families who cannot afford them. Most of the parents desire their children to have an education to help better their lives and future.

Our King's Day 2009 Celebration was with migrant families we assisted during the "2008 Into School Campaign." There were 450 in attendance.

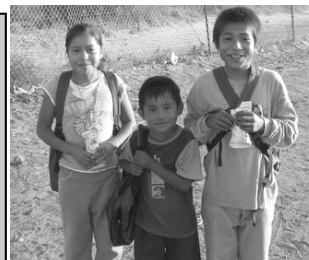
